So that your generations will see, perceive, acquire knowledge and become acquainted with; so that they will become aware by touch, smell and hearing; so that they will become aware by experience, so that they will become aware in a face to face, intimate manner that the children of Israel lived in booths when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I YHVH God.

**Freedom from slavery:**

**Romans 8:15** For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

**Spoils of Egypt – wealth beyond belief**

God gave the children of Israel the spoils of Egypt i.e., riches beyond belief. It was like winning the 100 million dollar mega ball with the multiplier but all that wealth meant nothing in a wilderness without a place to spend it. There where no malls ebay or shopping networks.
