**TRANSLATION:**

Transfer from yourself the quickly moving, crushing waves of a loud whirlwind of work and deeds which you produce by labor and fabricate with your hands; onto Yahweh; and the way we think; our meditations, purposes and counsels will come to exist firm and upright in us.

**NOTE:**

This is why going to church is so important! We don't go to church to fill up. We go to church to clear out. We should clear our minds of everything that doesn't pertain to God and concentrate solely on Him, because when we do, He will establish our thoughts, i.e. we will hear His voice.
