

186. To slay idolatrous citizens and to burn the city; as it is said,

**Deuteronomy 13:15** Thou shalt surely smite the inhabitants of that city with the edge of the sword, destroying it utterly, and all that *is* therein, and the cattle thereof, with the edge of the sword.

**NOTE:** This was not a random order to kill people who worship other gods. It was a specific order to kill those who are in covenant with God (Jews) who turn away and serve false gods.
